Meth Lab Interdiction Training

Class will be provided on June 11-12, 2012

On June 11-12, 2012 the Meth Lab Interdiction Training will be held at the Cranston Police Training Complex and hosted by the Cranston Police Department. This is a 16-hour training program designed to prepare officers to identify items used in the illegal manufacture of methamphetamine and the hazards specific to each of the four meth labs operating in the United States. Your job requires a certain amount of risk already let us reduce that risk with our training. Officers completing the training will be able to:

- **Recognize all four meth labs within 30 seconds**
- **Know the hazards specific to each meth lab**
- **Understand air quality concerns specific to meth labs**
- **Be able to articulate items visually identified in a meth lab site**
- **Understand specific scenarios in meth labs leading to the use of deadly force**
- **Identify equipment limitations, contamination, exposure and DECON**
- **Use robotically assisted 'clear' techniques when needed**
- **Identify meth lab items during traffic stops**
- **8 hours of practical hands-on training of traffic stops, role player interaction.**



Tuition includes all training material and supplies. This is a 16 certification program.
