On June 13-14, 2012 the Meth Lab Interdiction Training will be offered at Eagle Mountain House in Jackson New Hampshire and hosted by the Jackson Police Department. This is a 16-hour training program designed to prepare officers to identify hazards specific to each of the four meth labs operating in the United States. Your job requires a certain amount of risk already let us reduce that risk with our training. Officers completing the training will be able to:

- **Recognize all four meth labs within 30 seconds**
- **Know the hazards specific to each meth lab**
- **Understand air quality concerns specific to meth labs**
- **Be able to articulate items visually identified in a meth lab site**
- **Understand specific scenarios in meth labs leading to the use of deadly force**
- **Identify equipment limitations, contamination, exposure and DECON**
- **Use robotically assisted 'clear' techniques when needed**
- **Identify meth lab items during traffic stops**
- **8 hours of practical hands-on training of traffic stops, role player interaction.**

Tuition includes all training material and supplies. This is a 16 certification program.
